

Jeep Wrangler Upgrades

The traditional-shape Wrangler has been given some late-2009 improvements.



The optional (\$1500) Off-road Pack that consists of an electronically controlled rear axle differential lock, 3.73 axle ratio for manual and automatic models and a front sway-bar disconnect system is now available on both petrol and diesel Sport models.

The Uconnect™ Multimedia entertainment unit now comes with a 30GB hard disk drive.

These upgrades follow recent specification improvements that include a standard tyre pressure warning system; 17-inch aluminium wheels; automatic transmission diesel with 460Nm of torque; 85L fuel tank in Unlimited models; and a Dual Top standard on Rubicon and Rubicon Unlimited.

We're still waiting for a diesel version of the Rubicon, which would make the Wrangler one of the most capable 4WDs ever built.
