

VW displayed the revised T5 range at the 2009 Frankfurt Motor Show. The latest models have revised front panels and lights.



A new four-cylinder turbo diesel engine with common rail technology and four states of tune is offered. The 2.0 TDI has figures of 62kW/220Nm, 75kW/250Nm, 103kW/340Nm and 132kW/400Nm. The 132kW version features series turbo-charging, with two turbos in tandem.

A new seven-speed dual clutch gearbox is optional, in conjunction with VW's 4Motion AWD system.

VW says the range has achieved an improvement of 10 percent in CO₂ emissions and fuel consumption.

Available equipment includes 16-inch, 17-inch or 18-inch aluminium wheels; Side Assist lane change, blind spot monitor; multiple airbags; ESC; hill-start assistance; hazard light actuation during emergency braking; Dynaudio sound system; touch-screen satellite navigation; USB interface; and climate control air conditioning.
